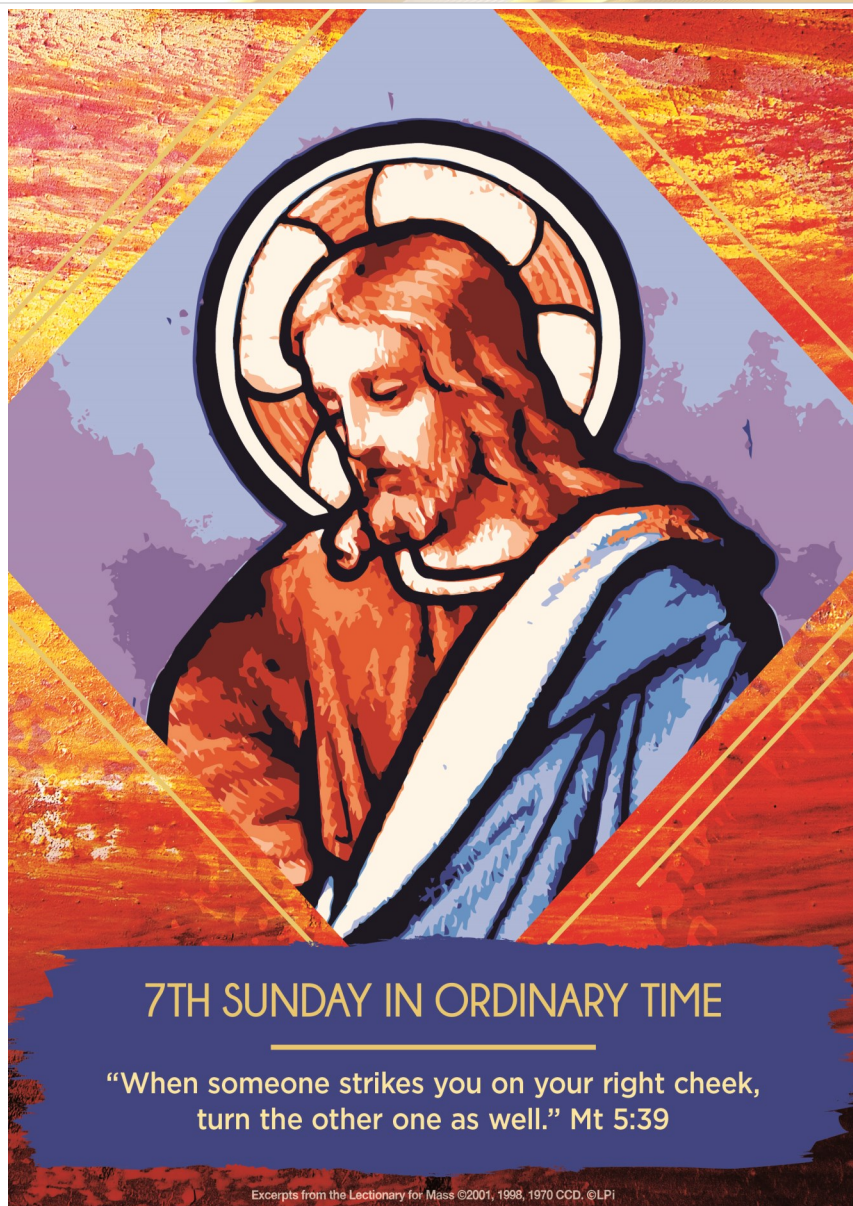

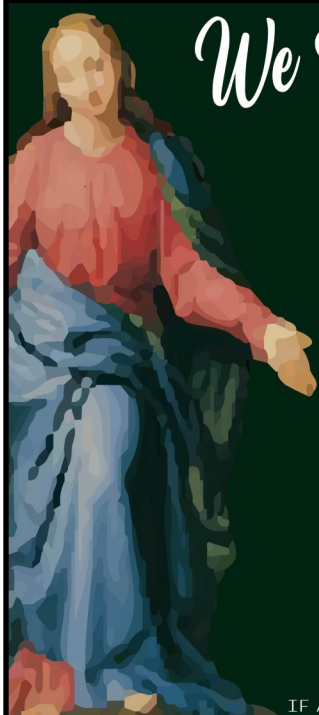

## "It's Giveaway Day at the Catholic Church"

We have all received phone calls from tele-marketers... *"Come spend a free weekend at our resort."* (along with a 2 hour presentation and a LOT of pressure to buy!) Or, *"We'll beat everybody's price... or your mattress is Freeeee!!"* We get excited at the thought of getting something for nothing, but we're a little leery as to *why* something may be free? There's got to be a catch!

Yes, the season of Lent is upon us and we are getting ready to receive our *ashes* and our *palms*. Every year Catholic churches are packed on Ash Wednesday and Palm Sunday. What other way to explain this phenomenon, except that we're getting something for free. Ash Wednesday isn't even a holy day of obligation and yet more people attend Mass on that day than on any other day of the year. Don't get me wrong, I'm delighted that we have so many people attending Mass on these days. I encourage priests to take advantage of the captive audience and preach about the real reasons we attend. Often times there are more people in line for ashes than for communion afterwards. Where did they all go? Did they really simply come for the *free* blessed ashes?

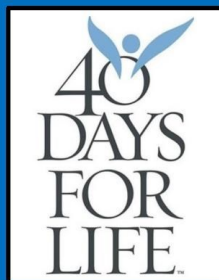
Leaving before communion at Mass could be compared to going to Grandma's house on Sunday and leaving before dinner. Grandma would certainly be saddened that you missed out on her homemade pot roast and apple pie for dessert. Most of us wouldn't want to offend our grandmother and we would always respect her home and honor her traditions. The same holds true for our Church. It is the Lord's House and we, as Catholics, believe He is truly present in the Eucharist. He invites us to come to the table every single Sunday and join Him in His heavenly banquet. The holy Mass is about the closest thing we have to heaven on earth. It is that little taste, that morsel, of what it will be like in Heaven.

We are a church of symbols and signs in our rituals. Ashes on Ash Wednesday are certainly a powerful symbol about what the Lord tells us in Genesis 3:19 and Ecclesiastes 3:20, paraphrased: *"From ashes to ashes and dust to dust."* These verses remind us of our mortality and how our life here is very short compared to the eternity that awaits us in heaven. We are made from the dirt (dust) on the ground and to dirt (dust) we shall return. Just like our holy water and the sign of the cross, ashes are a symbol of our Catholic identity. When we search for the true meaning of these beautiful symbols, we will be able to recognize the significance they have in showing the world, who we are and what we believe.

When you put on Christ, He becomes very real. He is not just a symbol. When we receive Him, we become like Him, and ALL benefit from the beautiful graces that only our God can provide. So my suggestion to Catholics, is to wear your ashes proudly, but make sure that you stick around for the **best** free gift of all..."The Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of the dearly beloved Son, our Lord, Jesus Christ.

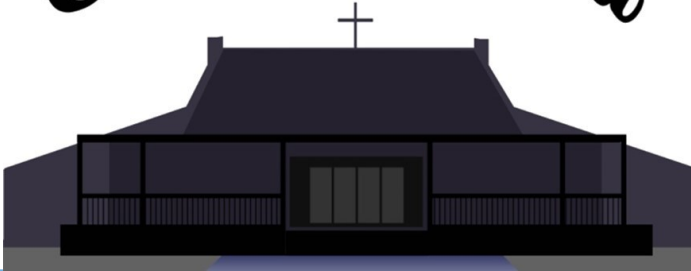

## GOSPEL MEDITATION ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

February 19, 2023—7<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Of all the things Jesus says which seem totally bat-crazy, this one might take the cake: **“But I say to you, love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you.”** An enemy is someone who desires the destruction of you, your projects, or those you care about. To love and pray for them is to want their health, strength, and flourishing. But if they thrive, they are more likely to hurt you and others. So, aren't you indirectly willing your own destruction, or that of your friends? If you doubt that this problem is embedded in this teaching, when was the last time you actually prayed honestly for the people you really hate?

How can we solve this riddle so we might actually live this command? Recall that enemy-love is the surest sign that you love someone with God's love, and not with indirect egotism. After all, if my love for my enemy ends up hurting me or my loved ones, it can't be for me. Enemy-love costs more because there are no tit-for-tats. No reciprocity — just loved poured out, and often pain in return. That's why it is so precious and rare. “What is unusual about that?” asks the Lord about love for our friends. Jesus wants us to experience the unusual love which only comes from him.

When Jesus was being killed on the cross, he was loving his executioners. In fact, he was holding them in being as they nailed him to the cross. He loved those who were spiritually piercing his Mother's heart, *while they were doing it*. And when he rose from the dead, he showed us that this kind of love is always worth it. It's stronger than death. Real love is unusual.

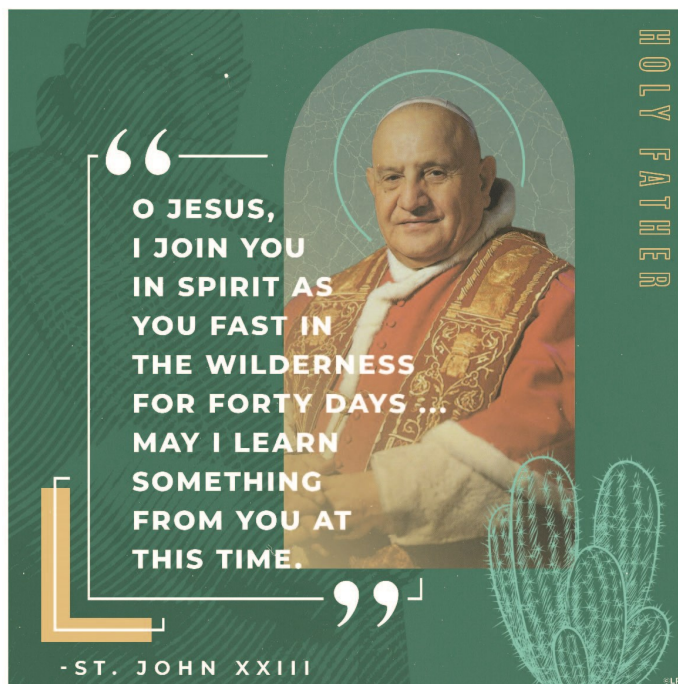

# Eucharistic Miracle of FAVERNEY

FRANCE, 1608



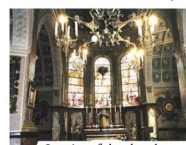
On the Vigil of the Feast of Pentecost, the monks of Faverney decided to expose the Blessed Sacrament for public adoration. During the night, a fire flared up which destroyed the altar and the sacred furnishings, but not the monstrance containing the Sacred Host. The monstrance was retrieved after a few days while it was suspended in the air perfectly intact. The miraculous Host is still kept today and many are the pilgrims who every year hasten to venerate the miracle.



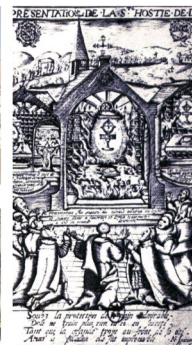
Stained glass window of the church in which the miracle is portrayed

In the 17th century, Protestantism and Calvinism spread quickly in France by means of the many material benefits conceded by the new religions to the members of the nobility and the clergy coming from the Catholic Church. This placed at risk the faith of many and created many uncertainties, even in the monasteries. In the city of Faverney there was a Benedictine Abbey whose monks had departed a great deal from the rule of their founder. They held only the highest esteem for the devotion to the Lady of Notre-Dame la Blanche, known in all the area for its many miracles. Through her intercession many miracles had in fact been verified, among which was even the returning to life of two infants who were not yet baptized. In 1608, on the Vigil of the Feast of Pentecost, the monks decided to prepare an altar for the exposition and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The lunette of the monstrance was very

large, and because of this, they decided to put in two Hosts. When Vespers had finished the monks left the monstrance exposed on the provisional altar.

*On the next morning*, the sacristan opened the church and found it full of smoke, with the provisional altar completely reduced to ashes. He started to yell, and immediately the religious and other people hastened and proceeded to remove the ashes with the hope of finding some part of the monstrance. When the smoke began to clear, they were astonished on seeing that the monstrance was suspended in the air. The multitude increased and crowded to see the Eucharistic marvel, in which the Hosts had remained unharmed regardless of the fire. The religious were astonished and unable to make a decision. They asked the counsel of the Capuchin friars of Vesoul. The friars immediately prepared a

new altar over the burned one and celebrated Holy Mass. During the elevation of the Host, the monstrance slowly descended upon the new altar. When the canonical process finished, on July 10, the Archbishop of Besançon declared that the miracle was authentic, and on September 13, the Archbishop of Rodi, who was the nuncio in Brussels, made it known to Pope Paul V who granted a *Bull of Indulgence*. The miracle rekindled the faith of many. In 1862, the Congregation of Rites authorized the celebration of the miracle. In 1908 the third centenary of the miracle was solemnly commemorated with a National Eucharistic Congress. Even today it is possible to see and venerate the relic containing one of the two Hosts which remained unharmed. The other Host, unfortunately, after it was donated to the Church of Dole, was destroyed by the revolutionaries in 1794.
