Beating the Traffic

Growing up in Southern California, I frequently attended various sporting events. Whether it be baseball games at Dodger or Anaheim Stadiums, Laker games at the Forum or even horse racing at Santa Anita, the thing I noticed was that many people had a tendency to arrive *after* the game started and then leave *before* the ninth inning, the fourth quarter or the ninth race, whichever the case might be. The object, I assumed, was to beat the traffic. I remember doing the exact thing when the Angels were playing the Yankees in Anaheim one summer evening. The Angels were behind 7 to 1 and it was the bottom of the eighth inning. As far as I, and the thousands of other fans leaving were concerned, the game appeared to be over. Lo and behold, the Angels came back to score six runs in the ninth inning and ended up winning it in the tenth. I had missed the highlight of the game as I listened to it on my car radio on the way home. I beat the traffic all right, but I missed the most exciting part of the game. I guess it just seems to be a Southern California mentality...we're willing to risk giving up what could be the best part of the event, just to avoid being stuck in traffic.

Many Catholics seem to have the same reputation...rushing out of church to "beat the traffic". It may mean leaving right after communion or maybe just a few minutes before the closing song is over. Some may also have difficulty making it before Mass begins. But coming to church and going to a ball game are two *very* different activities. One is for pure enjoyment and relaxation and the other is for the nourishment and salvation of our soul. Sometimes we confuse our obligation to come to Mass as an activity that is optional. As people who live a Catholic way of life, we recognize the importance of what we do when we come together on Sunday.

The Church tells us that we have an *obligation* to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. I like to think of it more as an *opportunity* to come and worship our Lord and Savior. Celebrating Mass is an opportunity to receive Him in the Eucharist and to come to the table as believers who are in communion with each other and with the church. If we make a habit of arriving late or leaving early, what are we saying to the rest of the community? And, more importantly...what are we saying to our Lord? Why should we deprive ourselves from experiencing the fullness of the Mass? Before we begin, it is highly recommended to prepare our hearts in prayer and silence so that we may give Him the very best of ourselves. And after Mass, as we are sent forth, it is good to stay a few minutes to contemplate and give thanks for all of the great things He has done for us. Then, we are able to gather outside as a community of love and faithfulness to share our *current* friendships and take the time and opportunity to make *new* friends.

Ideally, as a loving Catholic community who understands our faith, we can be full of excitement to arrive...not really ever wanting to leave. When we attain that kind of love and commitment to Jesus Christ and His church, we will never again think twice about 'beating the traffic.'


Tagalog Corner





Eucharistic Miracle of BENNINGEN

GERMANY, 1216



In 1216 the village of Benningen was the location of a Eucharistic miracle in which the Host bled. A few years later in 1221, the citizens of Benningen began the construction of a chapel in honor of this miracle which is known as *Riedkapelle zum Hochwürdigen Gut*. From 1674 to 1718 the Riedkapelle was rebuilt and enlarged to accommodate the large number of pilgrims. Each year, during the Feast of Corpus Domini (Corpus Christi), the parish of Benningen makes a procession to the Riedkapelle, to celebrate the commemoration of the miracle.

An ancient document of 1216 tells the story of two millers who, for years, had been at odds with each other. One day, one of them, exasperated by yet another argument, received Holy Communion and then afterwards stole a consecrated Host that he then hid among the stones of the mill of his neighbor with the intent of slandering him. During the Feast of St. Gregory, the Host began to bleed so profusely that all of the village and the Bishop learned about it.

The blasphemous miller repented and confessed his misdeed. The paintings of the chapel built in honor of the miracle were done by Johann Friedrich Sichelbein to illustrate the story. The portrait above the altar shows the Bishop of Augsburg, Frederick, who deposited the Host in

a precious container in the Church of St. Martin in Memmingen. In the course of the centuries, owing to historical events, the traces of the precious relic were lost. For a long time, it was believed that the paintings that adorn the Chapel were copies of those exhibited in the Monastery of Ottobeuren. Only during the restoration of 1987 was it discovered that the paintings were the originals. On the wooden ceiling there are frescoes illustrating the Passion of Christ and scenes from the Old and New Testament.
