

#### He's Coming

The seasons are changing, the fall colors are evident and the air is becoming crisp, cool and clear. We are entering the season of Advent in the Catholic Church and like our outside world where things are changing we will begin to see changes inside our church, and hopefully in our hearts. The Advent season is the

beginning of the Church year and it starts today. There are four Sunday's in Advent, (not necessarily four weeks). This year the fourth Sunday of Advent falls on December 24<sup>th</sup>. But wait, you say, isn't that

Christmas Eve? And don't we celebrate Christmas on that day? The answer is yes and no.

Contrary to popular belief and what Wal-Mart and Macy's tells us, the Christmas season does not begin until the Christmas Vigil on December 24<sup>th</sup>. On December 24<sup>th</sup>, Catholics are obliged to come to Mass for the Fourth Sunday of Advent and then once again at the Christmas Vigil or on Christmas Day. There is no

two-for-one special'. On those dates, we get two opportunities in a row to receive Jesus. But let's get back to Advent.

The word Advent comes from the Latin word 'Adventus' which means coming or arrival. We celebrate Advent as a season of hope. This hope comes from the promise that Christ gave us.... that he will come again. To prepare ourselves for this second coming, the church helps us by changing the environment in our worship space. The colors are changing from green (ordinary time) to violet, (a penitential symbol).

We also have an Advent Wreath that is made up of four candles (three violet and one rose colored) and a circle of branches. We Catholics cannot take credit for the development of the Advent Wreath; we have to thank our Lutheran friends for that. The wreath is loaded with symbolism and that is one reason that the church has adopted its use. The wreath itself is usually made from evergreens and it symbolizes our God who has no beginning and no end. The progressive lighting of the candles symbolizes our hope and

anticipation of the coming of Christ. The rose colored candle is lit on the third Sunday, formerly referred to as 'Gaudete' Sunday, taken from the Latin translation from St. Paul's letter to the Philippians 4:4, Gaudete in Domini semper, which means 'Rejoice in the Lord always'. We are half way to Christmas and we rejoice that we are that much closer to celebrating the first coming of Christ. We are encouraged to also have an

Advent wreath in our homes so that we can prepare the way for Christ by allowing peace and love to enter into our homes and our hearts.

The changes that we will notice in the Mass are: violet colored vestments and accents; the lighting and blessing of the Advent wreath; there is no Gloria sung or recited, (this is done "So that on Christmas night the song of the angels may ring out anew in all its freshness;") and there is a solemn blessing over the people at the end of Mass. The readings for the first Sunday are apocalyptic; the second Sunday, John the Baptist

prepares the way, leading us to the third Sunday as John the Baptist announces the coming of Christ, calling us to greater good. Finally, on the fourth Sunday, Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth, who acknowledges Jesus in her womb. The long waiting period of Advents anticipation slowly begins to break as we look forward to the good news of Christmas and the birth of our Savior.

So, how do we put into practice, this penitential attitude and remove ourselves from the distractions of everyday life? And how do we stay alert, so that whenever the hour or the day comes, we are ready? We do so by deliberately removing ourselves from the world and entering into that sacred space we call 'church'.... and we do it more than just on Sundays. If there was ever a time to begin going to daily Mass, this would be it. We have the opportunity to follow the readings, day by day, that lead us to Christ's coming.

Our own parish community is helping us prepare by hosting an Advent Parish Mission. We are able to gather as a community of believers to pray together, learn together and worship together so that we may come to know, love and serve the Lord better and better each day. We also have a Parish Penance service on

Dec. 13<sup>th</sup> where we ask for God's forgiveness of our sins.

All of these things help us so that we can come to Him with a clean heart on Christmas Day, as we sing with all of the angels, "Gloria in excelsis Deo!"


