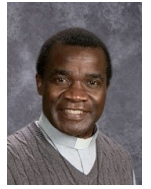

Let's Have a "Mary" Christmas

No, I didn't make a typographical error. I want to explain why Mary, the mother of Jesus, plays such an important role in the Christmas season, as well as in our journey of faith.

From the earliest days of the church, Christians have had great love and devotion for the Blessed Virgin Mary. On Dec. 8th, we celebrated the feast of the Immaculate Conception. Many of my Protestant friends have told me that they believe in the Immaculate Conception as well. Unfortunately, they are a bit confused by the term. This feast celebrates the Conception of Mary, born without sin. They, along with much of the mainstream media and even some Catholics, think that it is the conception of Jesus in Mary's womb. The conception of Jesus is referred to as the Incarnation. Our God needed a perfect vessel to bring His Son to us, hence Mary was born without sin and given salvation from her Son in the womb.

Mary, who is very visible during Christmas, waited for nine months, as she alone knew of God's ultimate display of love for us. With the birth of Jesus setting the tone of all our prayers during this season, we focus on the Son of God, "*The Word made flesh*". This gift was brought to us through the Blessed Virgin, who is the pure instrument used by God to bring His Son into the world. Mary is never far from her Son in the prayers of the church during the Christmas season.

From the Christmas vigil to the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God on Jan. 1st, a special prayer at Mass recalls... "*that day when Mary without loss of her virginity gave the world its savior.*" This time is referred to as the octave of Christmas where we have specific feast days. Every one of these eight days is celebrated with the same significance as Christmas Day.

Dec. 27th is the feast day of St. John the Apostle, the only Apostle who was not martyred. Scripture suggests to us that Mary was entrusted to St. John at the foot of the cross: "*Woman behold your son*, and to the disciple he said, *behold your mother*" (John 19:26). Mary was also aware of the massacre of infants in Herod's attempt to kill the newborn Messiah. (Matt: 2:16) The church celebrates this feast on Dec. 28th, the feast of the Holy Innocents. This year, Dec. 31st is the feast of The Holy Family, Jesus, Mary and Joseph. JMJ (For those of you old enough to remember, when in Catholic school, we wrote those initials on the top of all our papers) Jan. 1st is the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God. We then move past the octave to Epiphany, this year falling on Jan. 7th, where Jesus is manifested as the Son of God in the visit from the Magi. Mary was most certainly present then.

Contrary to popular belief, the church does not celebrate 'Groundhog Day' on Feb. 2nd. Instead, on that day, we celebrate forty days after Christmas with The Presentation of Jesus in the Temple, as described in the Gospel of Luke 2:22-38. This is when Simeon said that "*Jesus became a revealing light to the whole world*" and to Mary he said: "*and you yourself a sword will pierce*" (Luke 2:35) foretelling the suffering that she would go through when she would watch her son suffer and die.

We then come to March 25th, the feast of the Annunciation. (Luke 1:26-38), where the Angel Gabriel appears to Mary and she conceives Jesus through the power of the Holy Spirit, '*The Incarnation*'. We wait nine months and start all over again.

From the first moment when our promise from God was delivered, Mary cooperated with His plan by saying "yes". By her "yes" she became the perfect instrument, the vessel, the tabernacle and the ark that brought us our savior. No human being spent more time with Jesus, on this earth, than his mother Mary. For thirty-three years she was with Him and she even stood by Him at the foot of the cross.

Jesus gave her to us at the cross and she continues to lead us back to Him with her instructions at the wedding feast at Cana: "*Do whatever He tells you*" (John 2:5) These are the last words that we hear from Mary in scripture and they are the words that have rung true for two thousand years. Mary, our mother, wants us to join her in walking towards the light of her Son and she continues to be the model of love and devotion that we give to our God.

Jesus loved and honored His mother, so we too, shall love and honor her. Not only do we, as Catholics, desire to keep Christ in Christmas, but we also need to have Mary in our Christmas as well.

Jesus, Mary and Joseph, pray for us!
Our Lady Queen of Peace, pray for us!

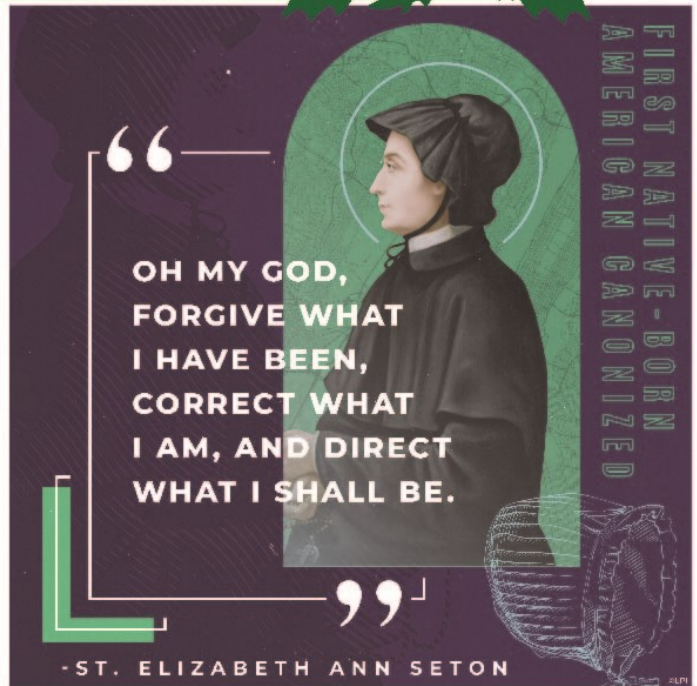
