
Week 1 God is Love & Mercy



#### SPIRITUAL JOURNEY with St. Faustina

Jesus said to St. Faustina: "Tell the world about My MERCY and My LOVE. The flames of mercy are burning within me. I desire to pour them out upon human souls. Oh, what pain they cause Me when they do not accept them! Tell aching mankind to snuggle close to My MERCIFUL HEART, and I will fill it with PEACE. Tell all people that I AM LOVE AND MERCY ITSELF. When a soul approaches me with TRUST, I fill it with such an abundance of graces that it cannot contain them within itself, but radiates them to other souls" (Diary 1074).

REFLECTION: When I stop to consider the Divine, what attributes do I assign to God? Do I see a God of justice? A God of love? A God of compassion? A God of jealousy? Do I often consider the merciful aspect of God?

#### "Going to the Chapel... And You Want Me to Leave My Flowers?"

There is song that's been around since the early sixties titled, "Chapel of Love", which has touched the hearts of many brides as they prepare to walk down the aisle. The lyrics speak of getting married and how... "Spring is here and the sky is blue"...because we're ... "going to the chapel and we're going to get married... going to the chapel of love."

Almost everyone loves to be invited to a wedding. We feel honored that the bride and groom have included us as they begin their new life together. As honored guests, we too, look forward to the day and want to participate fully in the joyous festivities. The priest or minister always alludes to the importance of the friends and family who gather to witness the joining of husband and wife.

In the Catholic Church, much preparation is required of the couple before they marry. They must participate in enrichment courses so that they understand fully what they are about to undertake. For two baptized people, marriage is a *sacrament*; it is a bond that cannot be broken. They confer the *sacrament* to one another with covenants and promises, sealed by God through His minister (the priest) and by the witness of His Church (the people). The couple learns of their responsibilities of bringing new life into the world. They are taught that the purpose of the sacrament is to unite them and to raise their children in the faith.

Most of these teachings and doctrines of the faith are readily accepted and honored by the soon-to-be bride and groom. But, when the coordinator explains to them that it is tradition to leave the flowers at the altar, all bets are off. "Leave the flowers? But we paid for them and we want them for the reception!" It can become a point of contention and the bride may feel slighted, considering that this is 'her' day and these are 'her' flowers. Hopefully, a proper explanation is given, helping her to understand why the flowers should be left at the altar.

Since Marriage is a *sacrament* for the baptized, it is also a blessing... not only for the bride and groom and those present at the ceremony, but for the entire community. In addition, every time a baby is baptized, a child receives first communion, a teenager is confirmed or a parishioner is buried, the church is blessed. *Every* Mass, *every* parish mission and *every* devotion celebrated in our community, leaves an indelible mark on the soul of our church. It is important that after a wedding takes place on Friday or Saturday, the community gathering on Sunday is made aware of this most recent blessing. The wedding flowers are a gift to God *and* to His Church. They are a symbol of new life and they express the love the couple has for each other, for the community, and for God. When the faithful walk in to Mass on Sunday, they immediately recognize, by the lovely flowers, that a wedding has taken place and our church community has, once again, been blessed.

For those old enough to remember, it was common practice, before a couple was married in the church, to announce the 'wedding banns' weekly. The names of the couple were announced, and the entire church community was informed of the intended marriage. This is no longer a practice in most dioceses and has somewhat faded from our traditions. As Director of Liturgy, I have requested of our pastor, that we include in our General Intercessions at Masses on Sunday, prayers for the couples married at St. Peter & St. Paul on that particular weekend, so that they, and *all* newly married couples are remembered by our entire community.

I know this is a difficult tradition for most brides to accept, but if she truly believes that she is entering "The Chapel of Love," she would understand that the *love* comes from God. 
