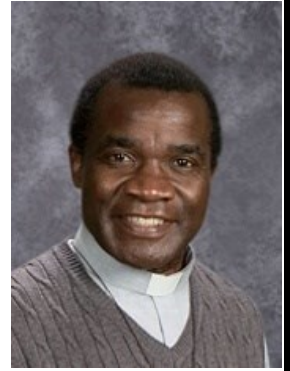

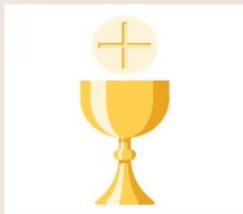

Blessing of work tools on the Feast of St. Joseph the Worker

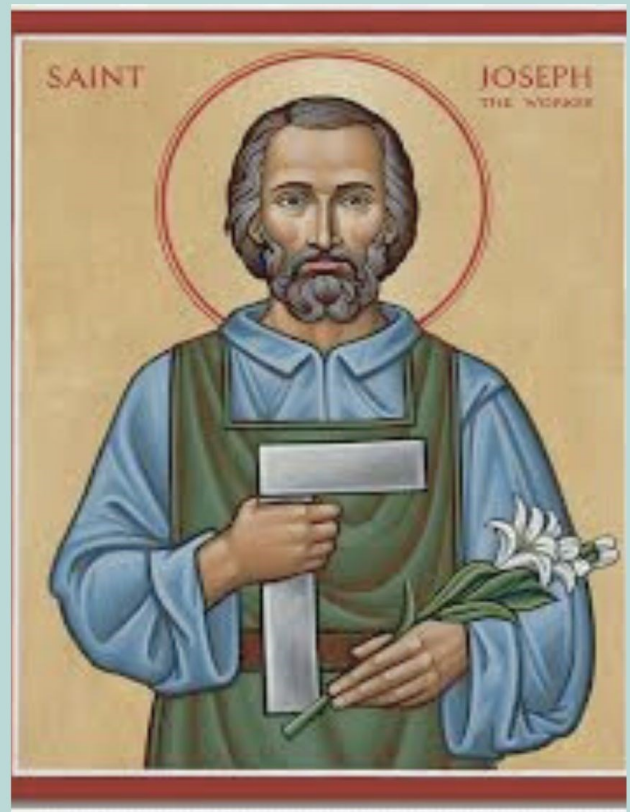

Tagalog Corner

Ngunit alam nating sa pagdating ni Cristo, tayo'y magiging katulad niya, sapagkat makikita natin kung sino talaga siya.

See what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called the children of God. Yet so we are.

The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him.

Beloved, we are God's children now; what we shall be has not yet been revealed.

We do know that when it is revealed we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.

“Burning the Midnight Oil”

We have all heard this expression whenever we are working late or pressed for a deadline. We have a tendency to stay up and force ourselves to finish an important task. In school, we either have a report to complete, homework due the next morning, or we’re cramming for a test. If we are at work, we also have deadlines that we must meet, orders that must be filled or jobs that must be done before we leave. If we are a parent or a caregiver, we stay up all night with a loved one who is sick, praying or attending to their every need. We stay because we are committed to the job, the class or the person to whom we are linked. We usually don’t *plan* ahead for these late nights, but we don’t think twice about fulfilling our obligation.

These are tasks that we perform in our everyday lives. Every now and then, we may even forget to eat because we are attending to other matters. And, because of our busy schedules, it may be difficult to find the time to spend a few quiet moments with our Lord. Every hour is full and our schedules are hectic...always going somewhere or doing something.

We are truly blessed here at St. Peter & St. Paul to have weekly adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. From 8:15AM to 7:30PM every Wednesday, and from 8:15AM, Friday, until 8AM Saturday. This gives the opportunity to come and spend some quiet time with Our Lord in the Eucharist. He is placed on the altar, exposed for all of us, so that we may worship and honor Him. But more importantly, we can experience his peace. This quiet time of prayer and contemplation is vital to the health of our soul. In the garden of Gethsemane, while praying to his Father on the night he was betrayed, he asked Peter... “Could you not keep watch for one hour? Watch and pray that you may not undergo the test. The spirit is willing but the flesh is weak.” (Mark 14:37-38) Jesus was offering him an opportunity to gain strength for what was about to occur.

On some days we may come home from a hard day at work or long day at school and want to do nothing more than check our email, relax and watch a good movie or ball game. We simply don’t feel like doing anything else. But, Jesus offers much more than this. Making a commitment of spending *another* hour at church, in adoration can be difficult, but it is important to take the time and experience the unconditional love that our Lord has for us. Allow yourself to savor the calm and peaceful feeling of being in His presence. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament may seem peculiar to some, but if you trust in Him, He will not disappoint you.

So, if on a Friday night, you are unable to sleep, or you happen to be *burning the midnight oil*, instead of grabbing a snack and picking up your phone to check out social media, come to adoration and be fed by Jesus...our Lord and Savior. He is definitely great ‘food for the soul’.

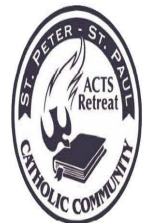

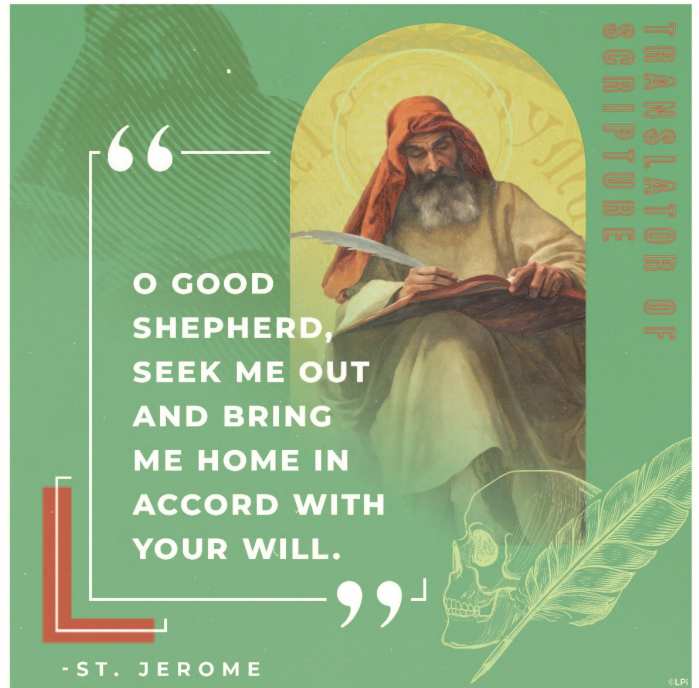


