





#### WHAT IS LECTIO DIVINA?

Lectio Divina means "divine reading" in latin. It's a meditative way of reading the Bible in which we let go of our own agendas and open ourselves to what God is trying to say to us.

Lectio Divina usually consists of four parts: *reading* scripture, *meditating* on the reading, *prayers* of thanksgiving and intercession, and *contemplation* where you rest in God's presence for a few minutes.

The mission of the Prayer Shawl Ministry is to celebrate life and bring solace and comfort to those people facing illness, loss or other catastrophic life changes.




