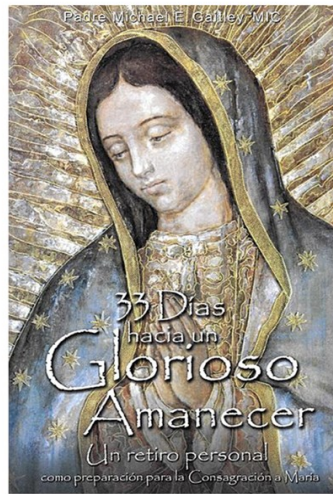
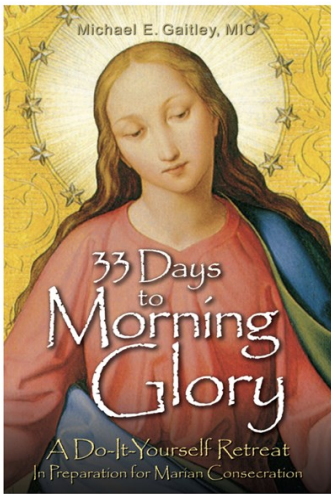
Tagalog Corner

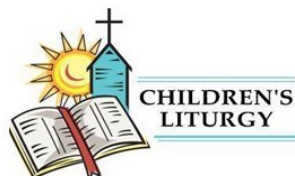
