The Three Main Presidential Prayers in the Mass are:

**1. The Collect (Opening Prayer):**

- Comes after the Penitential Act and the Gloria (when prescribed).
- The priest invites the people to pray, then pauses, so the people could offer their prayers silently, and finally prays the Collect, which gathers the intentions of the faithful and sets the theme of the Mass.

**2. The Prayer Over the Offerings:**

- Said after the Preparation of the Gifts.
- The priest prays that God may accept the gifts of bread and wine offered by the faithful, asking for the sanctification of these gifts and often linking the prayer to the day's liturgical theme.

**3. The Prayer After Communion:**

- Said after Communion and a period of silent prayer.
- This prayer thanks God for the gift of the Eucharist and asks for its effects to be realized in the lives of the faithful.

Presidential Prayers have the following characteristics:

- They are addressed to God the Father, through Christ, in the Holy Spirit.
- They are proclaimed aloud by the priest with the people listening attentively and responding "Amen."
- They express the official prayer of the Church and reflect the liturgical season, feast, or saint being celebrated.
- They are found in the Roman Missal, proper to each day or celebration.

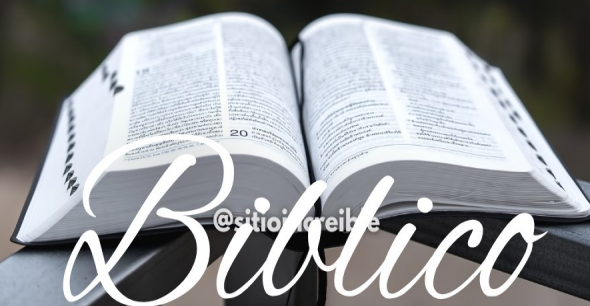

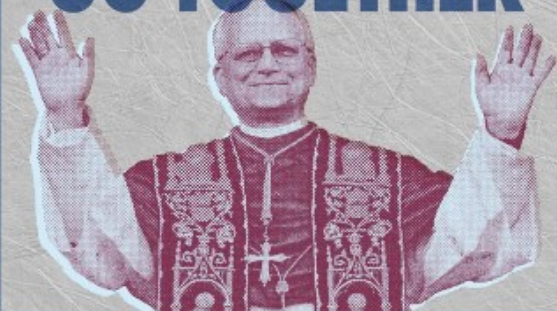
