The Liturgy of the Eucharist: The Sacrifice of Christ Made Present

The **Liturgy of the Eucharist** is the **heart and summit** of the Holy Mass. In this sacred action, the Church obeys the command of Christ:

“Do this in memory of me” (Luke 22:19).

Through the power of the Holy Spirit and the words of consecration spoken by the priest, **the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ**—a reality known as **transubstantiation** (CCC 1376). This is not a mere symbol, but the **true and real presence** of Christ, offered to the Father and given to the faithful.

The structure of the Liturgy of the Eucharist includes:

1. **Preparation of the Gifts** – The faithful offer bread, wine, and themselves to God.
2. **Eucharistic Prayer** – The central prayer of the Mass, which includes:
Preface and Sanctus (Holy, Holy, Holy)
Epiclesis – Invocation of the Holy Spirit
Institution Narrative and Consecration – The moment of transubstantiation
Anamnesis – Memorial of Christ’s Passion, Resurrection, and Ascension
Offering – The Church unites her sacrifice with Christ’s
Intercessions – Prayers for the living and the dead
Doxology – Giving glory to the Trinity
3. **Communion Rite** – The faithful, prepared by the Our Father and the Sign of Peace, receive the Body and Blood of Christ.
4. **Prayer after Communion** – A concluding prayer of thanksgiving.

This sacred action is both **a sacrifice and a banquet**: As a **sacrifice**, it is the re-presentation (not a repetition) of Christ’s one sacrifice on the Cross. As a **banquet**, it nourishes the faithful with divine life, deepening their union with Christ and with the Church.

The Second Vatican Council affirms:

“The Eucharistic sacrifice is the source and summit of the Christian life” (Lumen Gentium, 11).
