The Concluding Rites: Sent Forth to Live the Gospel

The **Concluding Rites** mark the final part of the Holy Mass. Though brief, they carry deep significance: they remind the faithful that the Eucharist is not the end, but the **beginning of the Christian mission** in the world.

The structure of the Concluding Rites includes:

1. **Announcements**(if necessary) – Brief notices or reminders for the community.
2. **Final Blessing** – The priest imparts God’s blessing, strengthening the faithful for the journey ahead.
3. **Dismissal** – The deacon or priest sends the people forth with words such as:

*“Go forth, the Mass is ended.”
 “Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord.”*

These words are not just a polite farewell—they are a **missionary command**, echoing Christ’s sending of His disciples:

“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations” (Matthew 28:19).

The word **“Mass”** itself comes from the Latin “Ite, missa est,” meaning **“Go, you are sent.”** This expresses the truth that every participant is called to **carry Christ into the world**, transformed by the Eucharist to live as His witnesses in daily life.

As the Catechism teaches:

“The liturgy in which the mystery of salvation is accomplished most powerfully helps the faithful to live out the mystery in their lives.” (CCC 1068)



My dear Parishioners of St. Peter & St. Paul,

I wish to reflect on a very pressing issue in our time—immigration—and do so in the light of Sacred Scripture and the teaching of our Church. This is not a political speech. It is a pastoral call to conscience.

In the Book of Exodus, God hears the cry of the Israelites in Egypt. He delivers them, not because they earned it, but because He is a God of mercy. And He commands them: "You shall not wrong a stranger or oppress him, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt" (Ex 22:21).

This command formed the moral identity of Israel. They could never forget what it felt like to be displaced, mistreated, or enslaved. The same must be true for us.

Many of us are descendants of immigrants—Italians, Irish, Filipinos, Poles, Mexicans—who crossed seas and borders seeking freedom. We are here today because someone welcomed them or at least let them try. That hospitality is part of our inheritance. We cannot enjoy the fruits of that sacrifice and deny it to others.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us two vital principles: Nations have a right to regulate immigration. And, Migrants have a right to seek a life of dignity. This is not a matter of "open borders" versus "no borders." It is about just borders, where laws protect the common good and still preserve human dignity. But human laws are not perfect and we must neither idolize law nor abandon prudence.

Let us not forget: Jesus Christ Himself, as a baby, fled to Egypt. As an adult, He had "no place to lay His head." When we look at a migrant mother or a frightened child crossing a border, we are not looking at a stranger. We are looking at Christ.

"I was a stranger, and you welcomed me." (Matt 25:35)

Let us avoid Pharaoh's mistake. In Exodus, Pharaoh fears the Israelites' growing number. Fear hardens his heart. That same spirit tempts our culture today—to see immigrants only as threats, not as people. The Church must choose a better path. We must choose Moses over Pharaoh, faith over fear, compassion over control.

So what can we do? Pray for wisdom, for our leaders and our Church. Speak with charity, not anger. Support ministries that serve immigrant families. Defend human dignity, even when it is unpopular.

Our citizenship is in Heaven (Phil 3:20). We are all pilgrims and strangers in this world. May our response to the immigrant reveal not just who we are—but whose we are.
