**The Liturgy of the Word: God Speaks to His People**

The **Liturgy of the Word** is the first major part of the Holy Mass, in which **God speaks to His people through Sacred Scripture**. It is rooted in the belief that "in the sacred books, the Father who is in heaven meets His children with great love and speaks with them" (Dei Verbum, 21).

During this part of the Mass, the faithful listen to readings from the **Old and New Testaments**, including the **Gospel**, which holds a place of special honor. The structure usually includes:

1. **First Reading** – typically from the Old Testament,
2. **Responsorial Psalm** – a prayerful response to the first reading,
3. **Second Reading** – usually from the Epistles,
4. **Gospel Acclamation** – preparing to hear Christ speak in the Gospel,
5. **Gospel Reading** – the words and deeds of Jesus,
6. **Homily** – the priest or deacon explains and applies the readings,
7. **Profession of Faith (Creed)** – a communal affirmation of belief,
8. **Prayer of the Faithful** – intercessions for the Church and the world.

This liturgy is not merely a recollection of past events, but a **living proclamation** of God's Word that calls for a **response of faith**. As the Second Vatican Council taught, **Christ Himself is present in His word**, since it is He who speaks when the Scriptures are read in the Church (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 7).

Thus, the Liturgy of the Word prepares the faithful to enter more deeply into the mystery of the Eucharist, forming hearts to receive Christ more fully.






