Muling nagsalita ang Panginoon kay Ahaz: "Huming ka ng palatandaan sa Panginoon na iyong Diyos, mag-ing ito ay buhat sa malalim na libingan o sa kaitaasan ng langit." Ngunit sinabi ni Ahaz: "Hindi po ako hihingi. Hindi ko po susubukin ang Panginoon." At sinabi ni Isaias: "Makinig kayo, sambahayan ni David! Hindi pa ba sapat na subukin ninyo ang pagtitiis ng mga tao, at pati ang pagtitiis ng aking Diyos ay inyong sinusubok? Dahil dito ang Panginoon mismo ang magbibigay sa inyo ng palatandaan: Maglililihi ang isang dalaga at magsisilang ng isang sanggol na lalaki at tatawagin sa pangalang Emmanuel.

The LORD spoke to Ahaz, saying: Ask for a sign from the LORD, your God; let it be deep as the netherworld, or high as the sky! But Ahaz answered, "I will not ask! I will not tempt the LORD!" Then Isaias said: Listen, O house of David! Is it not enough for you to weary people, must you also weary my God? Therefore the Lord himself will give you this sign: the virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel.

WHAT IS LECTIO DIVINA?

Lectio Divina means "divine reading" in latin. It's a meditative way of reading the Bible in which we let go of our own agendas and open ourselves to what God is trying to say to us.

Lectio Divina usually consists of four parts: *reading* scripture, *meditating* on the reading, *prayers* of thanksgiving and intercession, and *contemplation* where you rest in God's presence for a few minutes.


