**Laetare Sunday: Joy in the Midst of Lent**

The Fourth Sunday of Lent is traditionally called Laetare Sunday. The word Laetare means “Rejoice.” On this day, the Church invites us to pause in the middle of our Lenten journey and remember that we are not walking toward sadness, but toward the joy of Easter.

Lent is a season of prayer, fasting, and repentance. It is a time to examine our hearts honestly and return to God more deeply. Yet the Catholic faith never sees repentance as hopeless or gloomy. On the contrary, we rejoice because God is merciful, forgiveness is possible, and Christ is leading us toward new life. Even our struggle against sin is a sign that God’s grace is at work within us.

Laetare Sunday reminds us that Christian joy is not the absence of sacrifice, but the presence of hope. We can be joyful in Lent because the Lord does not leave us in our weakness. He calls us back to Himself, strengthens us with His grace, and prepares us for the victory of the Resurrection.

As we continue our Lenten journey, may this Sunday encourage us to keep going with renewed hearts. We repent, but we do not despair. We sacrifice, but we do not lose hope. We walk with Christ, and Easter is near.

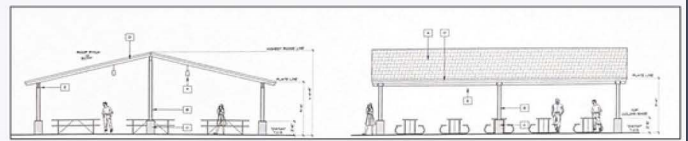

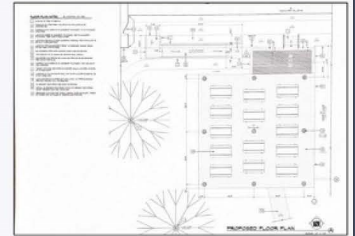
